### **UTILITY BILLS**

Utility bills are always due on the 10th of the month unless the 10<sup>th</sup> falls on a weekend, then they are due on the following Monday. After the 10th, there is a 10% penalty, and then if not paid we will disconnect on or after the 15th with a \$50.00 reconnect fee. If we have to come out after hours to reconnect your water or gas there will be an after hours charge. We have a drive thru window for your convenience, but if you use the window you must have your utility bill with you; also we have a drop box (located in the side door of the drive thru) for your convenience.
